Eligibility Requirements

- At least 18 years old
- Physically fit and able to lift 50+ pounds
- Pass TABE (literacy) assessment
- Meet daily attendance and punctuality expectations
- Successfully pass drug screen before and during training
- Consent to criminal background check

Lunch & Learns

Employers present to students in a 30/45 minute "Lunch & Learn," speaking about their industry, their company and any positions they are seeking to fill.

Hiring Fair

This is the employer's opportunity to hire a Construction Ready graduate. Companies interview and rank students in order of preference, and vice versa. Ranking sheets are turned in to CEFGA and matches are made.

Construction Ready Success

Since July 2014, more than 250 Construction Ready grads have been placed with 60-plus construction companies throughout metro Atlanta. Statistics include a 95% Placement Rate for Graduates, 89% Retention Rate at 90 days, and 71% Retention Rate at One Year

Upon Successful Completion, Graduates may earn up to eight (8) industry-recognized credentials:

- NCCER Core Credential (includes training in basic safety, construction math, hand and power tools, construction drawings, basic rigging and communication skills)
- OSHA 10 Hour Card
- First Aid/ CPR / BB/ AED Certification
- Powder Actuated Tool Certification
- Laser Certification
- Forklift Competent Person Safety Training
- D.O.T. Flagger Certification
- Fall Protection Competent Person Safety Training
