Service Electrician Apprentice Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to offer an opportunity to high quality young people who have just graduated high school or college, who have a great work ethic and are looking for a career in the electrical industry. This program will give an entry level apprentice an opportunity to be trained and develop the skill set of a Service Electrician. The role of a Service Electrician is coveted and very exclusive due to the highly technical requirements of the role. In addition to the high skill level, communication and self-presentation skills are required as well. The career of the Service Electrician is one that is held in high esteem and is very difficult to qualify for. This program, being offered by Capital City Electric, is unprecedented and will only be made available to the best and brightest. This program shall include fully paid tuition for 4 years at the IEC for apprenticeship training. You will also be employed by Capital City Electric and will be working on a service truck with a Master Electrician through the 4-year apprenticeship training. You will receive top pay and full benefits during this process. You may apply for this scholarship while still in High School. By applying while still in school you will be given direction and advice to help you qualify for the program once you graduate. In addition, if you apply while still in High School, you may be given the chance to work through the summer break to show us what you've got! A summer internship will give you a better chance of being selected when you graduate from High School.

Qualifications

- Must be 16 or older (to begin work). Under 16 may still enroll for guidance throughout their High School career.
- Must be in high school to submit application and must have a High School Diploma to be considered.
- Must be able to speak English and have good communication skills
- Must be mechanically inclined and have a basic understanding of hand and power tools
- Must be Safety minded
- Must have a valid GA driver's license the begin the program
- Must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Must have participated in Skill Trade competitions throughout your High School career
- Must have references from (3) teachers. References will be heavily weighed
- Must be physically fit
- Must have good High School attendance record with fewer than 10 days missed in a year.
- Must sign contract 5 year with Capital City Electric if selected for the program
- Interview, drug test, driving record and background check will be required. Cannot have a DUI or criminal record.
- Summertime work with Capital City from age 16 – graduation may be accepted.

Only 4 applicants per year will be selected for this program.
